Angelus: A Call to Prayer

- 2. Pray for Michael Sharp, his family, and for others affected by his and his co-worker's kidnapping in the DRC. Pray for the captors and those working for their release.
- 3. Pray for Vision Columbia's leadership team as they discuss and discern about a big change in direction, for the congregation.
- 4. As spring comes, please pray for those who are impacted by severe seasonal allergies. This especially affects those who are aging and are not able to be in air-conditioned settings. Pray that caregivers from Landis At Home can help those suffering in this way.
- 5. Ask the Lord for a revival in the Rohrerstown congregation (and all congregations) and surrounding community.
- 6. Pray that Tim and Julie Groff will have discernment in choosing between many possible ministry activities among the Garifuna people, in Belize. Pray also for their three boys, as they are undergoing a difficult adjustment to their new schools.
